groups and individual physicians and with other organizations to encourage the integration and importance of faith and health care. Our purpose and our focus remains the same.

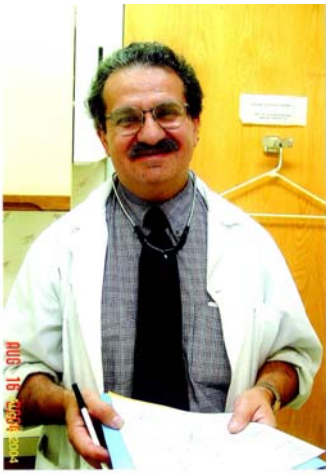
Our statement of faith remains the same, and we give all of the glory to God and pray that our centers and our mission will grow.
