Five US CMF (FaithCare) team members under the leadership of Dr. John Nwangwu, CMF Board member, joined a CMF Nigerian team of 45 volunteers, including 15 doctors for a 2 week medical mission to Ganye. They flew into Abuja, traveled on to Jos, and the next morning traveled 12 hours to the town of Ganye. The town is comprised of numerous villages and has a population of 10,000, with half of the population being Christian and the other half Muslim. It is situated in a valley between two beautiful mountain ranges. Ganye is in the far eastern remote sector of Nigeria, near the Cameroon and Chad borders. An excellent ministry relationship was established with JPRM (Justice, Peace and Reconciliation Ministry) during this mission. They provided housing, meals, water, and transportation for the team, enabling the treatment of thousands of Nigerians who would otherwise have no access to medical services.
